RECAP OF 12/13/19 MEETING NOTES:

- Multi-year permits possible (preference 5 years) via bid process, requiring permit fee.
- Deadline of January 31, 2018 for Parks Dept/Mayor's office to confirm requested variances (Additional days at Sunset for women's Championship. Duplication of Pipe Masters in January, replacing Volcom Pipe Pro).
- Deadline end of July to secure 2019/20 winter permits supported by amended rule changes.
- Pending approval of January 2019 Pipe Masters (in place of Volcom Pipe Pro), WSL intends to relocate annual world champion crowning gala to Hawaii in January, providing additional economic benefits to City/State.
- Added note: 2018 Pipe Masters will be the 48th annual. 2019 Pipe Masters would be the 49th annual. This is the longest running surfing championship tour event in the world. We would not want to see that record and legacy be lost from Hawaii.

PROPOSED CHANGES UNDER NEW DEPT. ENTERPRISE SERVICES/OED ALIGNMENT:

- Additional event build/tear dates.
- Permission to sell event merchandise on off-days. Proceeds reinvested into local events and community initiatives.
- Request for extended event day hours to accommodate better competitive conditions, and potentially finishing events sooner, freeing up park resource for the public sooner.

*WSL intends to withdraw from the Maui Women's Championship and replace with a final event to crown women's world champion at Sunset Beach, Oahu. Two (2) additional days required. Variance to be approved by the Mayor. Permission to add event that was not applied for in original application. This brings elite level women's competition back to the North Shore of Oahu, increasing women's representation.

**WSL will replace the Junior Men and Junior Women events with the first Women's Championship event of the 2019 WSL tour season. No additional days required. Need permission to swap events out. WSL will apply to add the Junior Men and Women events to a different location (Turtle Bay or South Shore). No loss of local opportunity since the Women's Championship will be held concurrently with the men's QS1,000 competition.

***WSL will replace the Volcom Pipe Pro with the Pipe Masters - the first Men's Championship event of the 2019 WSL tour season. No additional days required. Need permission to swap event out. Note that the (Volcom) Qualifying Series event will then move to the December Pipe Masters time slot (12/8/19-12/20/19) in the subsequent winter permitting period, thereby no loss of opportunity for local surfers.
